### Half Bottles: White Wine

Sonoma-Cutrer Chardonnay (375ml) 2018 Russian River Ranches (California) \$30  
Crisp, zesty lemon, green apple, lime and barrel spice. The wine rounds out with our signature citrus acidity and a nicely balanced long, flavorful finish.

Kim Crawford Sauvignon Blanc (90pts) (375ml) 2020 Marlborough (New Zealand) \$24  
Spicy honeysuckle notes add dimension to the core of juicy, fleshy apricot, nectarine, and passion fruit flavors, with plenty of intensity and spice on the finish.

Dry Creek Sauvignon Blanc (91pts) (375ml) 2019 Dry Creek (California) \$24  
Tones of lemon rind, stone, and lychee. Textured and lively in acidity, it has complexity and approachability in equal measure.

Fleur de Mer Dry Rose (92pts) (375ml) 2019 Cotes de Provence (France) \$24  
Delicate aromas of fresh watermelon and cherry give way to a complex, refreshing palate. Layers of red berries and subtle citrus are complemented by a softly textured middle and a fine, cleansing, mineral finish.

Saracco Moscato D'Asti (92pts) (375ml) 2019 Moscato D'Asti DOP (Italy) \$24  
Soft, creamy texture from the fine bubbles and pretty, sweet freshly sliced peach and melon flavors.

### Half Bottles: Red Wine

J Vinyards Pinot Noir (375ml) 2017 Sonoma (California) \$24  
This silky wine opens with fruit notes of black cherry, blueberry and blackberry jam, with earthy and spicy hints of forest floor, freshly-ground coffee beans and clove. Well-textured acidity, fine tannins and suggestions of dark toast give the palate depth and complexity before a lingering finish highlighted by fruit notes.

Terrazas Malbec Reserva (92pts) (375ml) 2016 Mendoza (Argentina) \$27  
Presence of violets, ripe black cherry and plum aromas. Sweet and juicy mouthfeel delivers finesse, delicate tannins and an elegant finish of black fruits. Reveals a toasty and spicy character of black pepper and chocolate.

Coltibuono Chianti Classico (90pts) (375ml) 2014 Chianti Classico DOCG (Italy) \$24  
Aromas of iris, violets, cherries, tobacco and black pepper. The taste is dry with well-balanced acidity and tannins. In the mouth it is fresh and fruity, quite warm and persistent. The taste has hints of minerals, red fruit, leather and aromas of roasting.

Ruffino Riserva Ducale (90pts) (375ml) 2015 Chianti Classico DOCG (Italy) \$27  
Intense ruby red in color, this wine offers complex aromas of cherry, violet, tobacco, white pepper and a touch of flint. On the palate, it is well-balanced, with velvety tannins, firm acidity and a lingering finish of rosemary.

### Chardonnay

X-1 Brickhouse (93pts) 2013 Ribbon Ridge (Oregon) \$109  
Supple, spicy, polished and toasty, offering well-formed pear, peach and freshly turned earth flavors. This is an estate grown and produced blend of five Chardonnay clones and is certified organic.

X-2 Domaine Auvigue Pouilly-Fuisse Solutre (91pts) 2014 Burgundy (France) \$89  
The limestone soils of Solutre produce lively, mineral wines with aromas of white flowers and hazelnuts. A rich, round wine

### Sauvignon Blanc

X-3 Voss Organically Farmed 2017 Napa Valley (California) \$59  
Sourced exclusively from a single, organic vineyard in Napa Valley, this wine exhibits classic varietal characteristics of lemon and grapefruit on the nose, while vivid tropical fruits flood the palate. The finish is delightfully crisp and lingering.

X-4 Andrew Rich Croft Vineyard 2015 Willamette Valley (Washington) \$59  
Rich, round, with complex notes of mineral and fresh spring water in the finish. A perpetual favorite, it sells out quickly.

## *Sparkling, Cider, & Champagne*

- Z-1 *Veve Clicquot Champagne Brut (92pts)* NV *Champagne (France)* \$159  
 Veeve Clicquot's award winning, yellow label champagne has complex aromas of bright and ripe fruit, poached pear, grated ginger, and light cream. Excellent depth and bubble persistence.
- Z-2 *Marquis de la Mystèriale Champagne (90pts)* NV *Champagne (France)* \$99  
 This wine is soft and well balanced. An attractive dominance of Chardonnay in the blend with Pinot Noir gives an edge of minerality as well as fresh apple flavors.
- Z-3 *Field Recordings Pet Nat (90pts)* 2017 *Paso Robles (California)* \$49  
 An exciting alternative to Champagne! This fun & unique bottle of bubbles is made from Chardonnay with the addition of some dry hopped Nelson hops, giving it a fruity, citrusy zing. A little sour & a little bitter, this is extremely refreshing.
- Z-4 *Juve & Camps Cava Gran Reserva* 2016 *Penedes (Spain)* \$49  
 Deep, intense and elegant, initially it evokes notes of ripe white fruit. Its complexity gradually increases and the aromas typical of long ageing then appear. Hints of toast and a certain citrus background complete its distinguished aroma. Its creamy mousse is perfectly integrated on the palate, making its texture in the mouth simultaneously fresh, rounded and evocative.
- Z-5 *Mont Marcal Brut Cava Reserva* 2014 *Penedes (Spain)* \$45  
 Estate-bottled, among the best Cavas regardless of price. Excellent base wine made from Xarel-lo, Macabeo and Chardonnay. Aged 18 months on the yeast, disgorged upon order.
- Z-6 *Basandere Sparkling Cider* 2016 *Jaxu (France)* \$39  
 A blend of 19 estate-grown, heirloom varietals of apples. A finer and slightly sweeter take on the traditional Basque cider. Perfect after a few years of aging with complex aromatics and pronounced tannins. Keep in mind, this is no Angry Orchard Cider. Its highly acidic, which makes it a hearty cider. Apple pie, fresh flowers baking spice, red apples, and dried herbs, starts with a burst of flavor followed by natural bubbles that was the palate dry.
- Z-7 *Golden Love Brut* 2020 *Curico (Chile)* \$29  
 Looking for a great sparkling wine to start off your dining experience? Want to send a fancy bottle to another table or call for a toast for your coworker? This sparkling Chardonnay has bright pineapple, white fruits, and floral flavors. Fresh acidity and a creamy sensation. A wonderful wine to start out the night without breaking your bank!

## *Texas Reds*

- G-4 *Newsom Inception* 2017 *Texas High Plains (Texas)* \$129  
 This Red Blend was produced and bottled in partnership with Llano Estacado Winery/ This Cabernet Sauvignon, Sangiovese, Tempranillo, Cabernet Franc blend is from some of their oldest vines. A very complex red that is very fruit forward with a hint of spice.
- H-2 *Newsom Syrah* 2016 *Texas High Plains (Texas)* \$129  
 This Red Blend was produced and bottled in partnership with Llano Estacado Winery/ This Cabernet Sauvignon, Sangiovese, Tempranillo, Cabernet Franc blend is from some of their oldest vines. A very complex red that is very fruit forward with a hint of spice.
- E-15 *Newsom Cabernet Franc* 2016 *Texas High Plains (Texas)* \$109  
 This Cabernet Franc was produced and bottled in partnership with Bending Branch Vineyards. Made in 100% neutral oak, it offers a full bodied and smooth style Cabernet Franc, much different different than your typical tannic Cabernet Franc.
- G-2 *Pedernales Texas GSM Melange* 2016 *Texas Hill Country (Texas)* \$89  
 Medium in body, this wine provides aromatics of dried currants and strawberries with more earthy bramble, flint, and peppery notes. Dried strawberries and cherries follow on the palate combined with dried green herbs and cedar. Awarded GOLD at the 2018 Jefferson Cup Invitational Wine Competition. 39% Mourvèdre, 31% Carignon, 14% Tannat, 12% Grenache, 4% Syrah
- E-13 *Pedernales Texas Tempranillo* 2016 *Texas Hill Country (Texas)* \$59  
 Sold out at the vineyard, this 2016 Tempranillo won a Silver Medal at the 2019 TEXSOM international Wine Awards. Lighter-bodied and shows notes of red cherry, leather, spice and tobacco on the nose. Oak notes are also quite expressive on this wine with hints of vanilla, clove, and coconut. Tart cherry, thyme and sage are prominent on the palate and are completed by soft tannins.

## *Italian Reds*

- J-5 **Quorum Hastae Barbera D'Asti (93pts)** 2001 *Piemonte DOC (Italy)* \$249  
 This wine is full-bodied, with notes of tobacco, liquorice, & black cherries. The finish is well structured & lush. There is a rich acidity, characteristic of Barbera wine, but the acid is balanced by the elegant, soft tannins. Excellent aging potential. This wine explodes out of the glass with a huge nose of tar, spices, smoke, & sweet vanilla aromas.
- A-1 **Arcanum (94pts)** 2009 *Toscana (Italy)* \$239  
 68% Cabernet Franc, 22% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon. Bold blackberry juice & black cherry usher in plum, cassis, sweet tobacco leaf, dusty fig, raspberry, dried cranberry, cedar, bramble, sweet spice & a hint of white pepper.
- D-1 **Argiolas Turriga (90pts)** 2008 *Isola Dei Nuraghi IGT (Sardinia)* \$179  
 On the nose, black cherries & wild blueberries. Herbal notes of thyme & a subtle hint of eucalyptus & wood forest tones. On the palate, the combination of the woody forest floor, with the herbal tones taking first place. The fruits come into play but ever so mildly, just the cherries & a slight violet introduction, then a strong dark chocolate & followed with a punch of pepper. Leather comes into the show for a moment. Wonderous dry long tannins.
- L-3 **La Bracesca Bramasole Syrah (92pts)** 2008 *Cortona (Tuscany)* \$119  
 This is opulent and rich, with a thick, velvety texture and pretty aromas of blackberry, chocolate, leather & freshly milled white pepper.

## *Pinot Noir*

- A-12 **Romililly (91pts)** 2013 *Russian River Valley (California)* \$119  
 This wine shows a medium ruby color, leaning towards red. The nose is filled with toasted cherry, wet asphalt, and sandalwood. The palate boasts bright red fruits and earth, bracketed by medium acidity and fine velvety tannin, which leads to a long finish of toasty oak and fruit.
- B-5 **Panthera (91pts)** 2019 *Sonoma Coast (California)* \$119  
 Made by Hess Vineyard, this wine is brazenly rich, yet it stays refined and elegant. A hint of wood and liquorice round it out nicely, with strawberry, plum, baking spice, and earth on the palate.
- A-7 **Chamisal Vineyards Califa Selection (90pts)** 2010 *Edna Valley (California)* \$119  
 The wine boasts an expressive nose dominated by cranberry, raspberries and red plum, with ample underlying varietal notes of ripe stems, warm spice and earth. Bright red fruit flavors define the palate with fresh acidity, a seamless structure and a lifted strawberry character from the whole cluster fermentation
- B-7 **Etude Grace Benoist Ranch** 2016 *Carneros (California)* \$99  
 A vibrant red ruby color, it shows lifted red berry fruit flavors & aromas of fresh strawberry, bing cherry, & raspberry, along with the signature cinnamon graham cracker spice found in Etude Pinot Noirs. Appealing & bright, concentrated red fruit comes through on the palate, alongside delicate mineral earth & spice notes, followed by a lush mouthfeel & silky tannins.
- I-5 **Rossi Wallace** 2014 *Napa (California)* \$89  
 From Atlas Peak sites, this is a dark, brooding wine rich in earthy loam, pomegranate, cranberry and cherry that carries a fistful of weight and power and warm, smoky oak.
- C-11 **Elouan Oregon Reserve Klamath's Kettle** 2017 *Willamette (Oregon)* \$79  
 This Oregon reserve pinot noir shows with beautiful color, excellent depth, solid structure, and firm acidity. Lively notes of raspberry, cranberry, vanilla, and red cherry with hints of dry herbs. Rich and finessed, this Oregon pinot noir melds both ripe fruit flavors of cranberry, strawberry, and black fruit flavors of plum and currants. Exceptionally smooth tannins with a lingering finish.
- E-10 **Elouan Oregon Reserve Missoulan Wash** 2017 *Willamette (Oregon)* \$79  
 "Missoulan Wash" refers to the Ice Age era floods that exposed volcanic and sedimentary soil in Oregon's northwest corner. Deep magenta. Focused and complex with intense and lively aromas of strawberry, blackberry, and spice. Lush and elegant flavors of cranberry and blackberry with subtle layers of sweet pipe tobacco and cedar. Supple tannins with a lingering finish.
- E-7 **Silvan Ridge** 2014 *Willamette (Oregon)* \$75  
 This smooth and detailed wine mixes tart red fruits with earthy, lightly charred flavors. The robust tannins carry notes of espresso beans and dark chocolate.
- K-1 **Hook & Ladder** 2016 *Russian River Valley (California)* \$69  
 Aromas of vanilla bean and bright blueberry-cherry with slight notes of powdered cinnamon. Full ripe flavors of stone fruit, vanilla and dark chocolate pomegranate.

## Zinfandel

- J-3 Robert Craig *Black Sears Vineyard (95pts)* 2014 *Howell Mountain (California)* \$149  
When poured, this Napa pedigree is immediately evident, with deep blackberry & refreshing minerality at the forefront. Black Sears Vineyard has "King of the Mountain" bragging rights - topping out at 2400 feet, making it officially the highest vineyard on the mountain. Classically structured, with ample weight, offering a nice balance between flavor, alcohol, pH & tannin — melding the power of mountain Zinfandel fruit, bursting with warm red stones, wild bramble fruits, and a dash of ground white pepper.
- D-6 Frank Family Vineyard (93pts) 2018 *Napa (California)* \$89  
Fragrant earthiness lies beneath rich black cherry and plum flavors in this full-bodied wine. Mocha, cardamom, and baked cherry enhance the wine's refreshing acidity and powerful tannins.
- L-1 Sivas-Sonoma Old Vine (90pts) 2014 *Sonoma (California)* \$59  
A totally satisfying wine in its bringing together of velvety texture and flavors of pepper steak, juicy red berry and sultry cinnamon. Aged in American oak, it offers length and body in a ripe, rich package.

## Merlot

- A-10 Emmolo Merlot (91pts) 2015 *Napa Valley (California)* \$139  
This wine is not your average Merlot. You'll be excited to know that this wine is crafted by Jennifer Wagner, daughter of Chuck Wagner, the founder of Caymus Vineyards. It is heavier and opens with a mild ripe blackberry bouquet with hints of coffee. On the palate, this wine is full bodied, rich and extracted. The flavor profile is an ultra-ripe blackberry with notes of licorice, coffee and vanilla oak with a hint of boysenberry. The finish is dry and its flavors and big tannins are quite lengthy.
- A-13 Meeker Merlot *Handprint Collection* 2013 *Sonoma (California)* \$109  
This dark ruby colored Merlot is a bit bigger than your typical Merlot. It opens with an attractive mild plum and gentle black raspberry bouquet. On the palate, this wine is medium bodied, balanced and savory. The flavor profile is a mineral infused black raspberry with notes of plum and old oak.
- B-1 Tate Merlot *Joan Ellen Vineyard* 2011 *St Helena (California)* \$89  
Layers of cherry, boysenberry, cassis & clove are caressed with vanilla nuances from barrel aging. Ripe, supple tannins structure the wine & support the lush flavors. The long, fruity finish, laced with autumn spices, ends with a lively cranberry zing.
- H-1 Chelsea Goldschmidt Merlot 2017 *Alexander Valley (California)* \$59  
This is a fine wine, reflective of the vintage's generosity & approachable nature, giving off flavors of vanilla, cherry & currant alongside a sanguine, gamey character & smoky full-bodied ripeness.

## Malbec

- E-5 Red Schooner *Voyage 8 Malbec* 2018 *Fairfield (California)* \$139  
Love Caymus? They've done it again! This Malbec is made from grapes grown in the Andes Mountains, shipped chilled to Napa Valley and produced with the same techniques as the Caymus Cabernet. Falling outside standard labeling rules, it does not include a vintage date but is known by the voyage from which it traveled (Voyage 8 is the 2018 vintage). Offering scents of ripe plums and cherries, this wine is powerful and supple, with flavors of French oak and soft tannins.
- F-1 Belasco de Baquedano Swinto *Malbec* 2013 *Mendoza (Argentina)* \$89  
Made from 100-year old vines in Lunan de Cuyo area of Argentina, this wine is enhanced by malolactic fermentation in new French oak barrels and aged for 18 months. Dark, fruity, and minerally on the nose, with a luscious palate of rip red stone fruits and jams. Dense and unfiltered.
- B-17 Anko Flor De Cardon Malbec (92pts) 2014 *Salta (Argentina)* \$75  
Unlike the traditional, heavy, sweet style of Salta Malbec, this transmits the high, sunny plains of this northern region in a bright, tense red. From vines planted in 2007 in a very stony soil in the Tolombón area, this shows firm acidity that keeps the red berry and sour cherry notes fresh and vibrant.

## *Meritage, Blends, & Other Reds*

- Floor3 Montes *Outer Limits* Red Blend (91pts) 2010 Colchagua Valley (Chile) \$129  
 This wine has a generous bright ruby red color. The aroma suggests blackberries, dry fig, light cinnamon & a spiciness given by the light toast of French barrels.  
 A creative blend of 50% Carignan, 30% Grenache, & 20% Mourvedre
- I-11 Caymus-Suisun *Grand Durif* Petite Sirah (93pts) 2017 Suisan Valley (California) \$119  
 Dark and plush, this combines structure with polish, offering notes of ripe blackberry, dark chocolate, grilled herb and toasty spice that linger toward refined tannins.
- E-3 Austin Hope *Mourvedre* 2015 Paso Robles (California) \$119  
 A nose of prunes, raisin cake and dusty earth with hints of cinnamon stick and dark chocolate. Full-bodied, concentrated and packed with dried berries and exotic spice notions, it offers a chewy frame and just enough freshness, finishing long.
- D-5 Austin Hope *Mourvedre-Syrah* 2015 Paso Robles (California) \$119  
 Ripe and polished, with notes of creme de cassis, toasted bread, spice and vanilla, it shows more and more meaty, roasted herb and licorice characteristic with time in the glass. Full-bodied, concentrated and polished, with ripe tannin. 50% Mourvedre, 50% Syrah.
- C-17 The Prisoner *Red Blend (90pts)* 2019 Oakville (California) \$99  
 Since its arrival into the marketplace in 2000, this wine became an instant star. The 2019 vintage is the wine's best effort to date, and it signals its long journey to become the wine that everyone can wrap their palate around. Bold, black fruit, savory spices, and oak.
- J-1 Chateau Grand Bouchon Bordeaux 2012 Medoc (France) \$75  
 Born from an association between Hubert de Bouïard (Angéus, 1er grand cru classé de St-Émilion) and the Yvon Mau négoce business, here is a classic left-bank blend dominated by Merlot. Notes of cassis, cherry, raspberry and undergrowth, joined by a slight woody note, courtesy of the oak involved.
- F-4 Arrels de Clos Pissarra 2013 Montsant (Spain) \$69  
 Medium plus nose shows fresh style, white pepper, dried cherry, raspberry, potpourri, light earth or forest feel. Palate quite expressive, dried fruit complexities, raspberry, dried cherry, nice spice of pink peppercorn. Medium tannins give it surprising strength, acidity is nice, medium plus alcohol.
- M-2 Halter Ranch Synthesis (91pts) 2017 Paso Robles (California) \$69  
 Synthesis is an approachable Cabernet Sauvignon blend that has aromas of both red and black fruits and cassis, followed by flavors of black cherry and plums. Smooth and approachable, this wine is great on its own but pairs with virtually everything  
 82% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% Petite Sirah
- G-1 Conundrum Red Blend (90pts) 2019 Rutherford (California) \$59  
 A blend of Zinfandel and Petite Sirah. It is rich, complex and approachable. With lush flavors of cherries and baking chocolate, this wine has fine tannins that create a silky smoothness
- L-6 Cooper & Thief Red Blend 2018 Lodi (California) \$59  
 A dark and jammy red wine blend loaded with bourbon-inspired flavors and aromas with a velvety finish.  
 38% Merlot. 37% Syrah. 11% Zinfandel. 7% Petite Sirah. 4% Cabernet Sauvignon. 3% Other Red Blenders

## *Cabernet Sauvignon*

- A-17 **Cakebread Cellars (91pts)** 2016 *Napa (California)* \$199  
Aged for 17 months in 56% new French oak. Very deep garnet-purple in color, it comes strutting out of the glass with confident, classic cassis, warm plums and cedar chest notes with touches of pencil lead, bouquet garni and tilled soil plus a waft of cloves. Medium to full-bodied, the palate is laden with bags of black fruit and spicy sparks, framed by firm, grainy tannins and seamless freshness, finishing on a lingering earthy note.
- C-4 **Post Parade *Stretch Drive* (95pts)** 2014 *Napa (California)* \$179  
This wine oozes with provocative dark berries laced with crushed rock, cocoa and baking spices. It's made by Thomas Rivers Brown, whom you may recognize from Schrader, Revana, GTS, Maybach, Gemstone and Outpost. Brown made history as the first American winemaker to receive a perfect 100 Point score from the Wine Spectator, and has had more than a dozen 100 Point wines in his career.
- D-17 **Cooper & Thief** 2015 *Napa Valley (California)* \$109  
Aged for six months in High West Rye Whiskey Barrels, this rich wine has warm, dark fruit aromas, a lush mouthfeel, & supple tannins touched by hints of toasted rye spice. Complex on the palate & finishes with a smooth structure reminiscent of a fine rye whiskey.
- L-10 **Bonanza by *Chuck Wagner of Caymus*** Lot 3 *Fairfield (California)* \$75  
Medium ruby-red, this wine opens with scents of currants and dried roses, grape pomace, and freshly tilled soil. The nose is nuanced with toasty oak imparting a subtle smoked meat character. Flavors of blueberries and blackberries mix with the warmth of vanilla and toasted bread. Silky tannins and striking smoothness. Mouthwatering, lengthy finish trails off with the taste of unsweetened chocolate and cassis
- F-3 **Justin** 2018 *Paso Robles (California)* \$69  
This beautifully classic cabernet sauvignon is full of ripe blackcurrant, black & red cherries with vanilla, cedar, sweet tobacco, & licorice accents. Medium-plus body with dark fruit of cassis & black cherry on the entry. Barrel notes of vanilla & cedar with savory black tea & herbal notes come through on the mid-palate. A traditionally styled Cabernet Sauvignon in all respects.
- D-10 **Austin Hope** 2019 *Paso Robles (California)* \$59  
Intense fragrances of black currants, ripe black cherries, & blackberries with subtle notes of violets, mocha, & dried spices. It's a big, powerful, modern-styled wine with velvety tannins & heaps of juicy blackberry and cherry fruit, while nuances of cedar, clove, & vanilla bean round out the long, smooth finish. It's full-bodied, rich & balanced by fresh acidity with a supple, polished tannin structure.
- A-15 **Bartinney (92pts)** 2013 *Stellenbosch (South Africa)* \$59  
A fresh and racy style, with bright red currant and damson plum fruit flavors bouncing along, accented by savory, fresh tobacco leaf and mineral notes. Everything pulls together nicely through the energetic finish. Drink now through 2021. 250 cases imported.
- B-11 **Pillar Box (90pts)** 2012 *Padthaway (South Australia)* \$59  
The palate begins with dark berry fruit and earthy tobacco leaf characters which are layered over cedar spice and leathery tones. Subtle oak gives complexity and the wine is well structured and has smooth and fine tannins
- C-7 **Bleasdale *Mulberry Tree*** 2014 *Langhorne Creek (South Australia)* \$59  
An elegant wine with aromas of mixed berries, dark chocolate and violets. The palate is smooth with blackcurrant and spicy oak flavors and finishes with fine chalky tannins.
- C-9 **CP *Cali Paso*** 2017 *Paso Robles (California)* \$59  
Intense purple color. Aromas of red fruits, plum and cherry with an accent of herbs and spices such as tarragon and black pepper, as well as notes of tobacco and vanilla. Well-balanced, excellent structure, and a medium to long finish.
